GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- UNESCO World Heritage sites.
- Cap-Blanc: one of the most beautiful known friezes of prehistoric sculptures in the world.
- Laugerie-Haute: traces of human occupation from around 24,000 years ago.

Prepare to be amazed by a magnificent sculpted frieze! Discovered in 1909, the Abri du Cap-Blanc rock shelter is one of the greatest masterpieces of Magdalenian prehistoric monumental sculpture.

Explore the Laugerie-Haute site and follow in the footsteps of our Homo sapien ancestors at one of Europe's largest prehistoric shelters!

Laugerie-Haute bears traces of human occupation dating back between 30,000 and 19,000 years. An abundance of lithic tools, a high-quality bone industry, a large number of artistic manifestations, housing structures and evidence of cultural transition make this a site of key importance when

it comes to understanding the chronology of the Upper Palaeolithic.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The Cap-Blanc frieze today bears sculptures in high and low relief, but studies have highlighted the existence of ochre paint around the figures. We can only imagine that it was once fully coloured!
